Please follow the instructions below.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a High School Senior.
- Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of a minimum 3.0 (based on a four-point system).
- The scholarship must be used for Trade School, Community College, Jr. College or four-year University.

The following items must be submitted with your application in order to be considered for a scholarship:

- Applicant must submit an application.
- Applicant must submit a resume of school and community activities.
- Applicant must submit a typed essay of no more than 500 words and express "My goals – present and future and why I deserve this scholarship."
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with the applicant and their career interests.
- Applicant must submit copies of "current" official transcripts sealed, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Application must be postmarked by **April 1, 2018**. Applicants meeting the minimum requirements will be contacted and scheduled for an interview in May, 2018. The NLPOA SGV Membership Committee will screen and select the scholarship winners. The scholarship winners will be notified one week after the scheduled interview.
