Please follow the instructions below.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicant must be a High School Senior.
- Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of a minimum 3.0 (based on a four-point system).
- The scholarship must be used for Trade School, Community College, Jr. College or four-year University.

The following items must be submitted with your application in order to be considered for a scholarship:

- Applicant must submit an application.
- Applicant must submit a resume of school and community activities.
- Applicant must submit a typed essay of no more than 500 words and express “My goals – present and future and why I deserve this scholarship.”
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with the applicant and their career interests.
- Applicant must submit copies of “current” official transcripts sealed, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Application must be postmarked by **March 14, 2020.** Applicants meeting the minimum requirements will be contacted and scheduled for an interview on April 25, 2020 at the La Verne Library starting at 10:00AM. The NLPOA SGV Membership Committee will screen and select the scholarship winners. The scholarship winners will be notified one week after the scheduled interview.
