Please follow the instructions below.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a High School Senior.
- Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of a minimum 3.0 (based on a four-point system).
- The scholarship must be used for Trade School, Community College, Jr. College or four-year University.

The following items must be submitted with your application in order to be considered for a scholarship:

- Applicant must submit an application.
- Applicant must submit a resume of school and community activities. (No more than 1 page)
- Applicant must submit a typed essay of no more than 1 page, Arial in 12 Font, "Why I deserve the scholarship".
- Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with the applicant and their career interests.
- Applicant must submit copies of "current" official transcripts sealed, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** *Be mindful of school closures of Spring Break and COVID, be sure to request in a timely manner to make the application deadline. No extensions will be given.
- Application must be postmarked by **April 15, 2021.** Applicants meeting the minimum requirements may be contacted by email and scheduled a virtual interview. Once the interviews are concluded the NLPOA SGV Scholarship Committee will screen and select the scholarship winners. The scholarship winners will be notified via email.
